

## **Report. One Norbiton Police & Safety Meeting.**

1 Welcome extended to Mary Byrne, from the Panel (which has folded)

2 Sgt Ross informed the meeting that there is a change in the way that Safer Neighbourhood panel meetings will proceed. There will be quarterly meetings and virtual ward panels. That is surveys will be sent out by email and responses analysed. Day to day issues will be analysed as now. There will be a street a week programme starting soon but collection of emails as now will be very useful. The emails collected for Neighbourhood Watch can only be used by the police. There was great reluctance to get emails from residents and they were only given when told they were for Police use only. Using them for other purposes would be breaking Data Protection laws. Both Elaine & Sheila found this reluctance and both would feel very compromised if this policy wasn't adhered to. The police will keep the emails collected.

3 The next streets to be canvassed are Hawks Road and Gordon Road.

4 Wardens: There was a discussion re the role of wardens. A Job spec. will be put together – Elaine & Tony.

5 Fireworks. Sheila Griffin reported that a resident of the estate had a firework thrown into her face. Sgt Ross said the police had been on 5 day special duties regarding fireworks. Shops had been checked and more patrolling taking place.
