- Regular checks on street / balcony lighting
- Tackling dog mess
- Encouraging more open feedback on local safety issues
- More security for tower blocks
- More proactive measurers on tackling drug taking / dealing
- Rearranging shifts to focus on evenings and weekends
- More support for victims of domestic violence

It was felt that the best solution to all of these issues was a permanent police presence on the estates e.g. 'More Bobbies on the beat' or a Community Warden / Ranger.
